

Patricia Haley – Delta Sigma Theta Biography

SOROR PATRICIA HALEY is the award-winning, national bestselling author of *Nobody's Perfect*, *Blind Faith*, *Still Waters*, *Let Sleeping Dogs Lie* (nominated 2006 Best Inspirational Fiction), and *No Regrets, Chosen* (nominated Best Christian and Inspirational Fiction), and *Destined*. She self-published *Nobody's Perfect* in 1998 and her faith-based debut novel was the first of its kind to repeatedly make numerous bestselling lists, including #1 on the Essence list.

The trailblazing faith-based author is a project manager with an engineering degree from Stanford University and a M.B.A. from the University of Chicago. Patricia has been a member of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc. since pledging Epsilon Nu (San Francisco) in 1982. She is a charter member of Omicron Chi (Stanford Univ.) and Schaumburg Hoffman Estates (IL) Alumnae Chapters. Her other chapter affiliations include Pontiac (MI), Rockford (IL) Alumnae chapters, and is currently a member of Valley Forge (PA) Alumnae. Over the years, she has served as chaplain, committee chair, financial secretary, etc.

Patricia is a born again believer who lives with her husband, Jeffrey Glass, and daughter in the Philadelphia area. She is active in the church and has sung in the gospel choir, served on the leadership committee for various financial, budgeting, stewardship, and building programs. Her latest series, *Chosen* (released in 2009) was nominated for best Christian fiction of the year by the African American Literary Award Show as well as the premiere Romance Slam Jam Emma Award for Best Inspirational Fiction. The novel kicks off a series depicting the modern day story of King David and the family drama associated with choosing his younger son instead of the eldest to take control of the family business. Book #2, *Destined* releases 2010, followed by the third installment in 2011.
